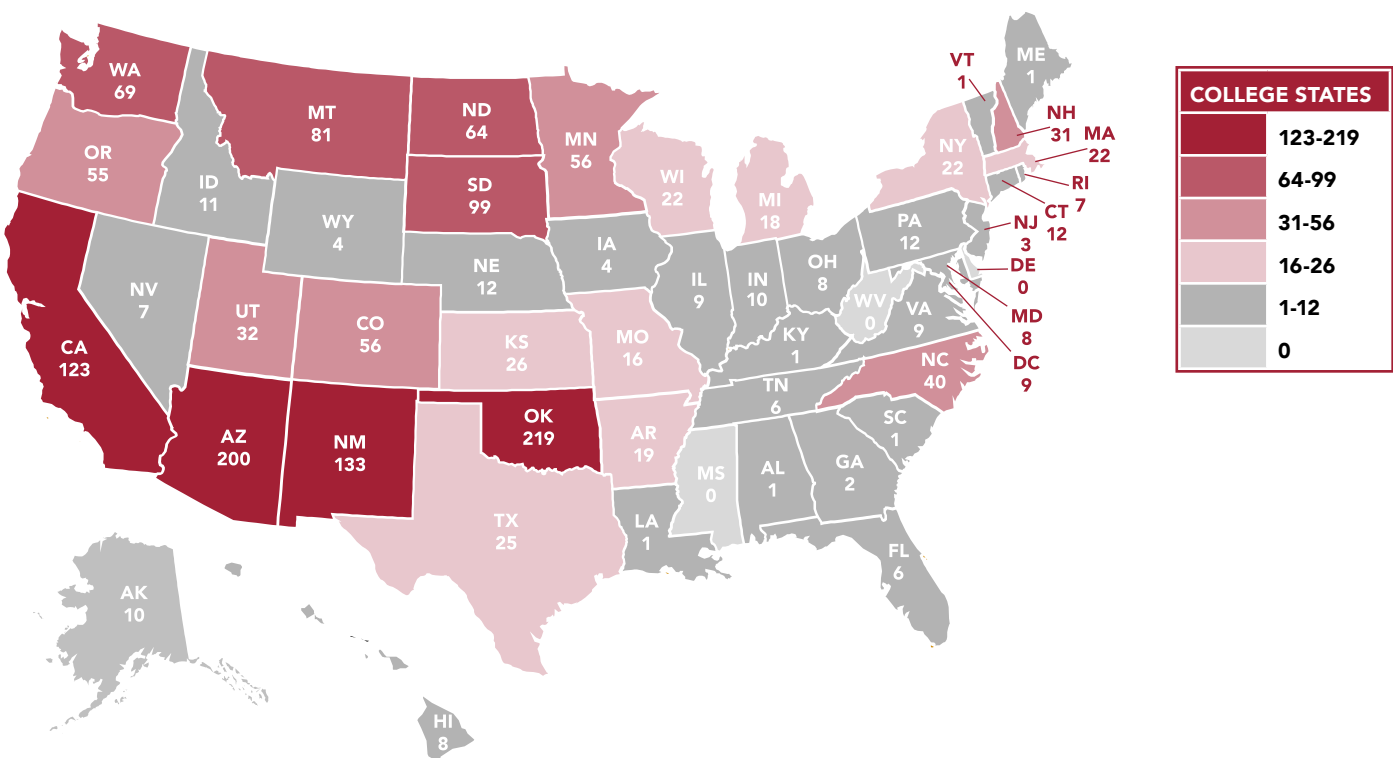
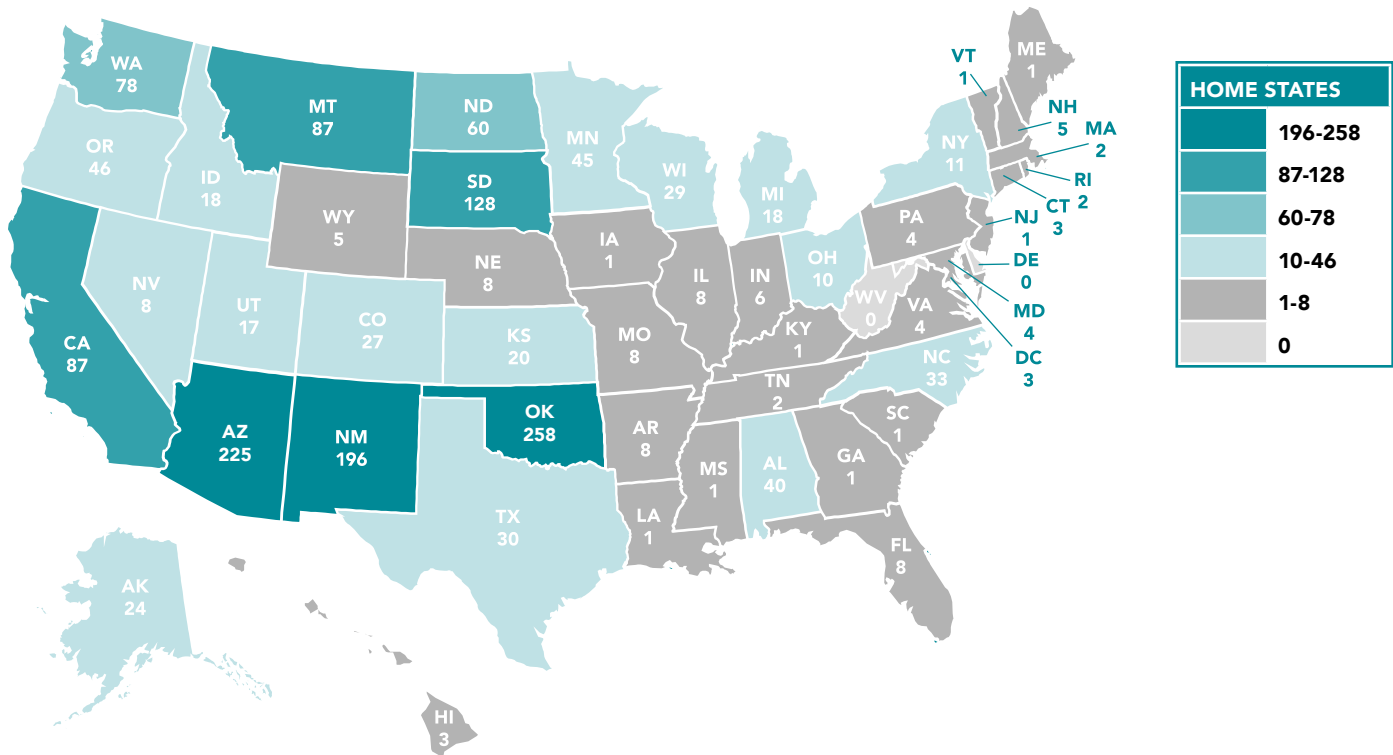

2016 Geographical Scope

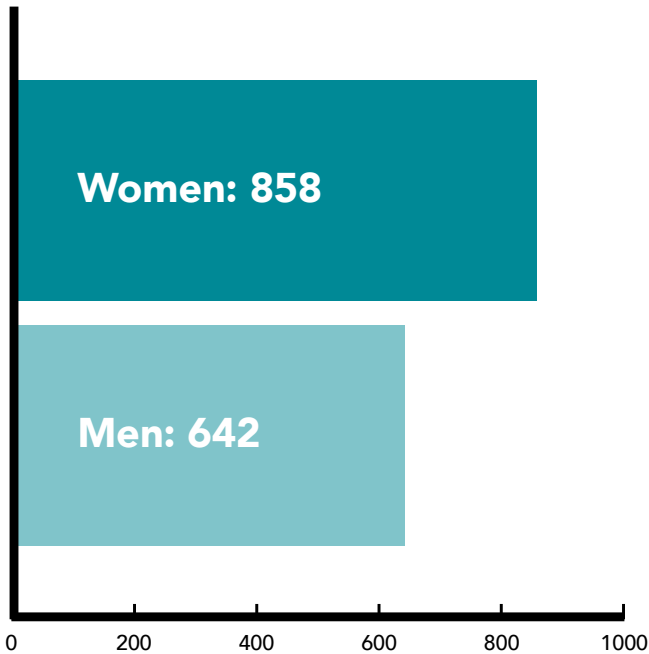
Student Home & College States



2016 Number of Students Served

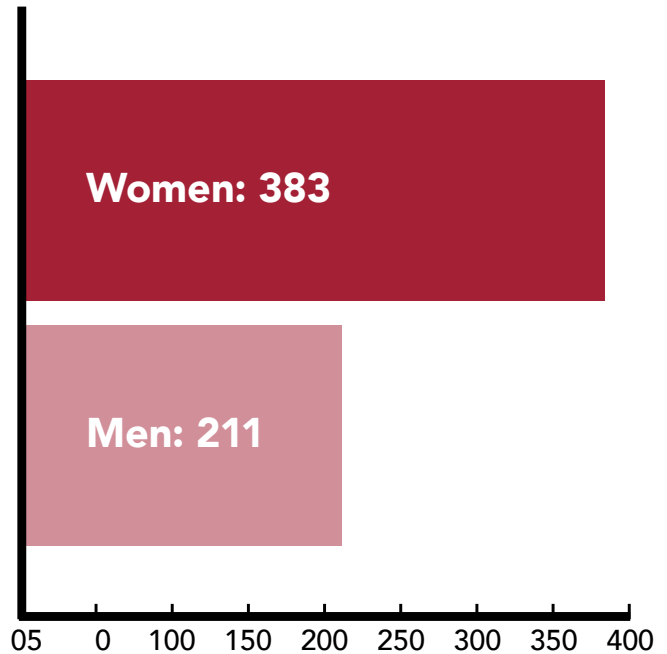

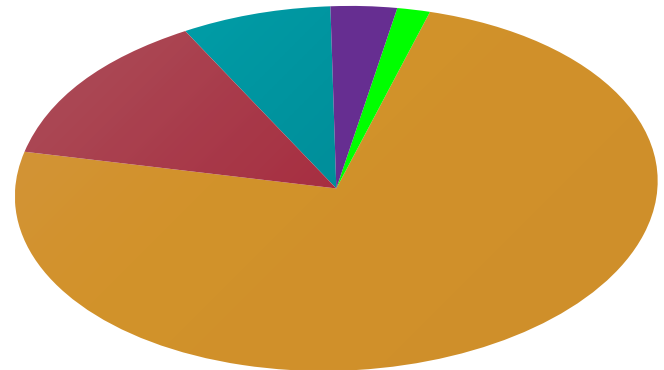

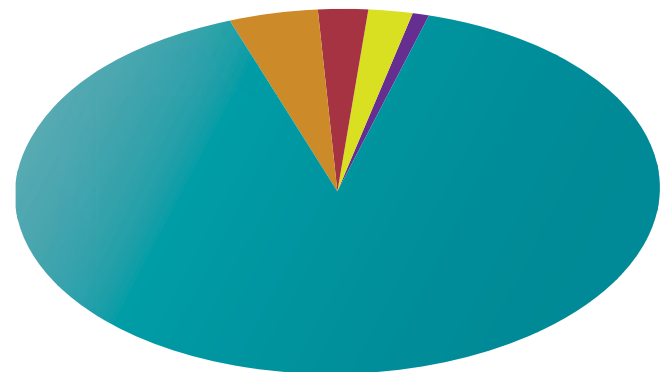
