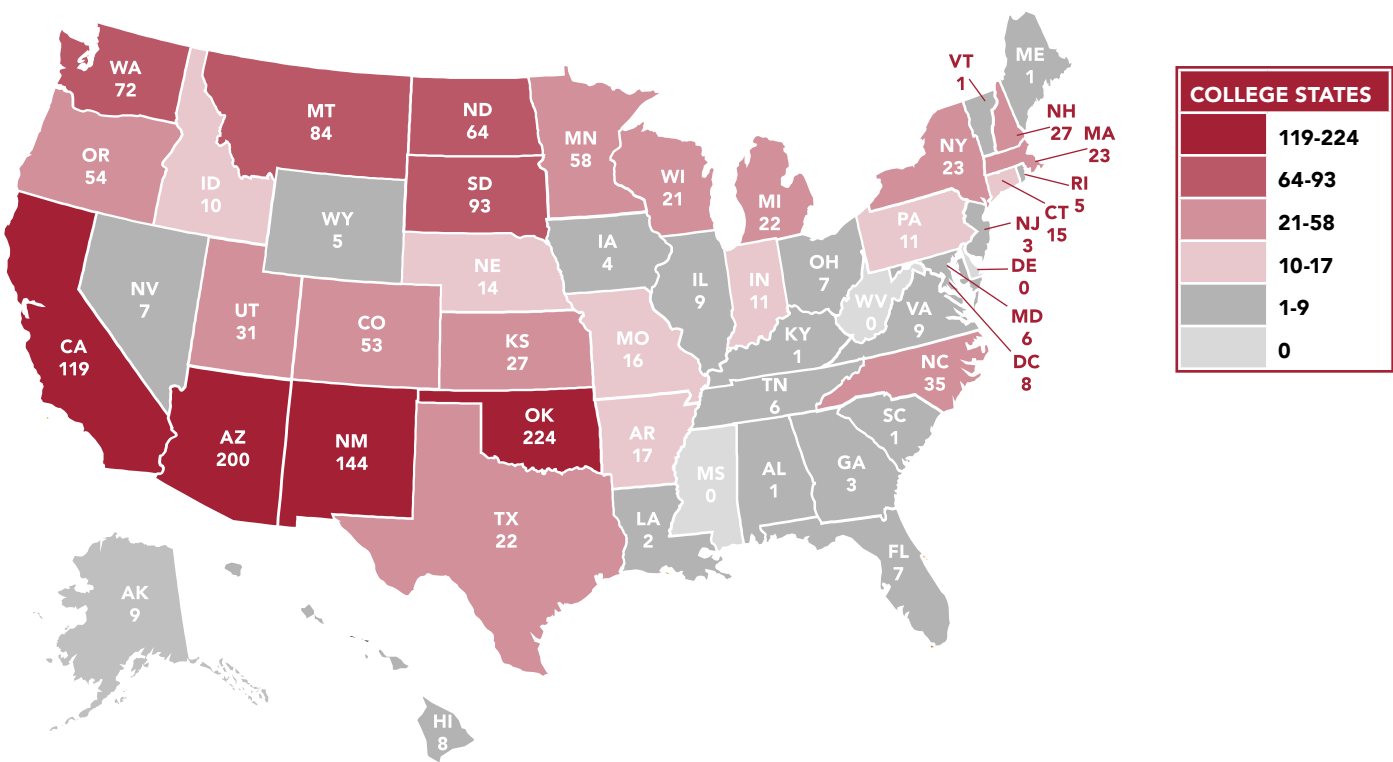
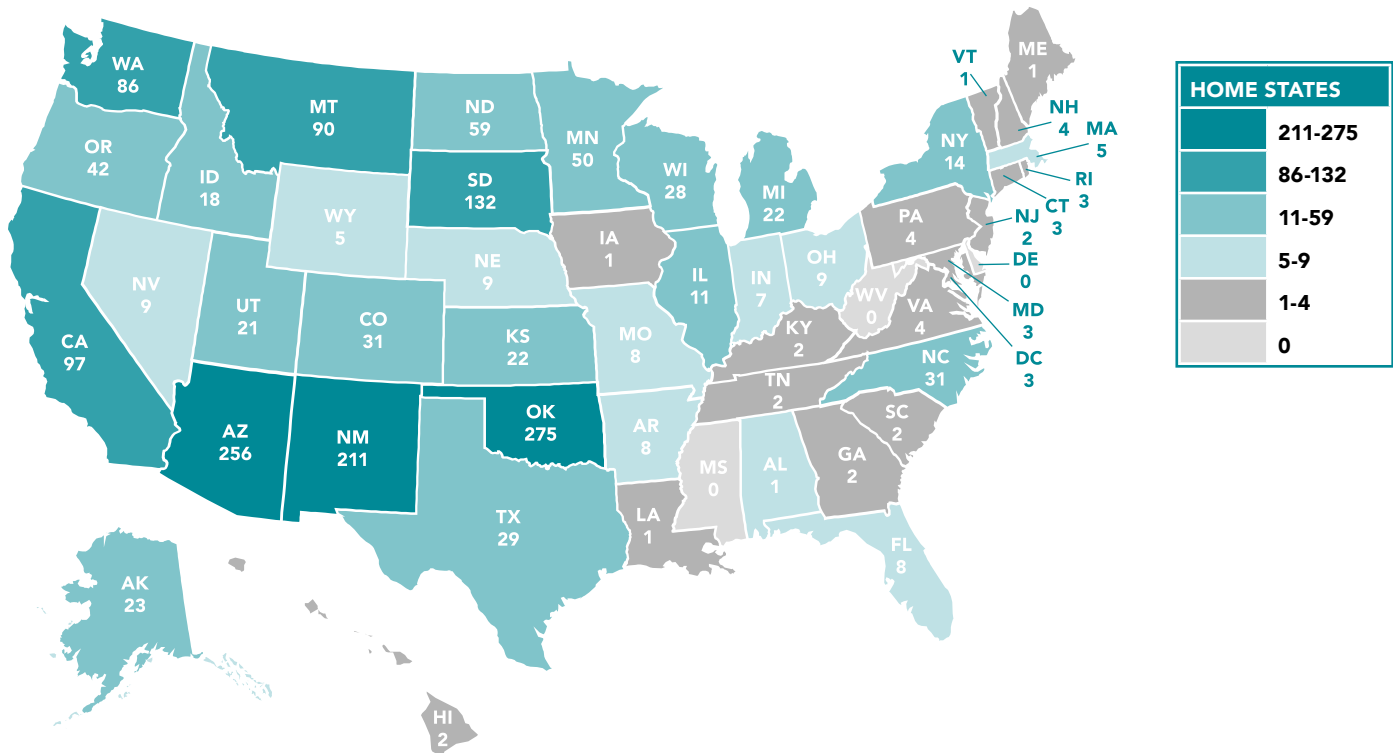

# 2016 Geographical Scope

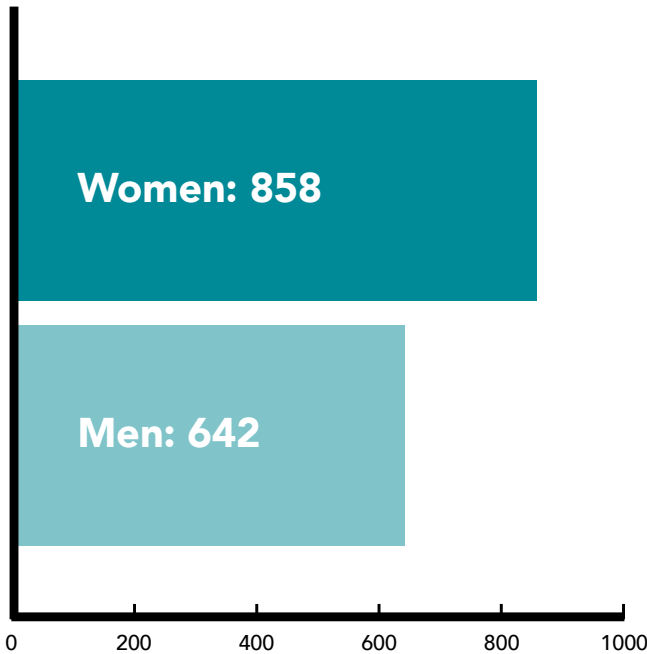
## Student Home & College States



# 2016 Number of Students Served

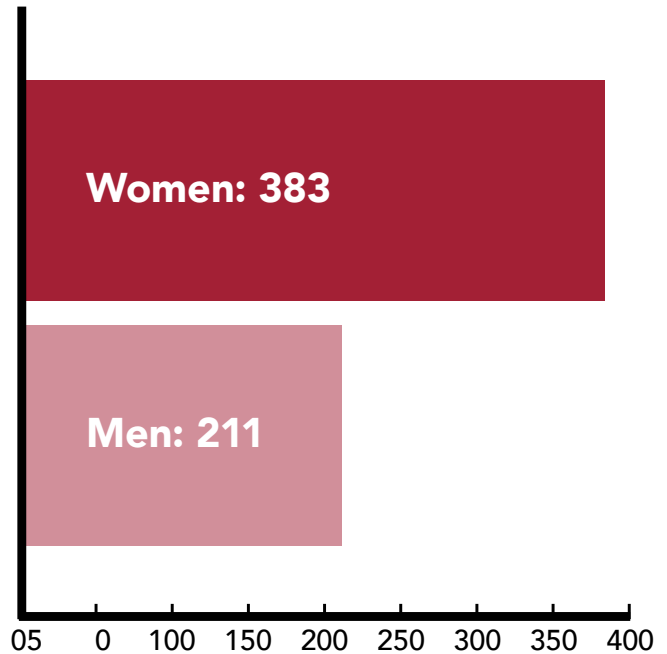

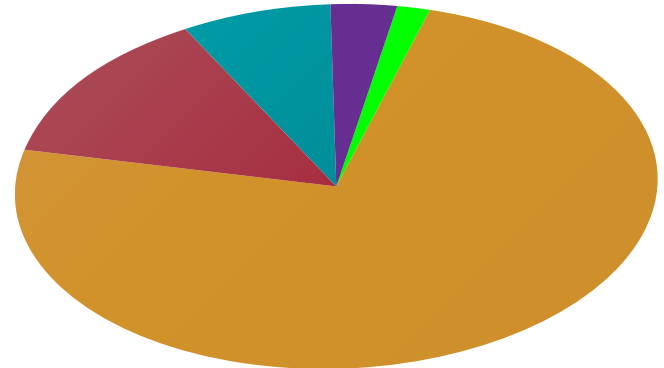

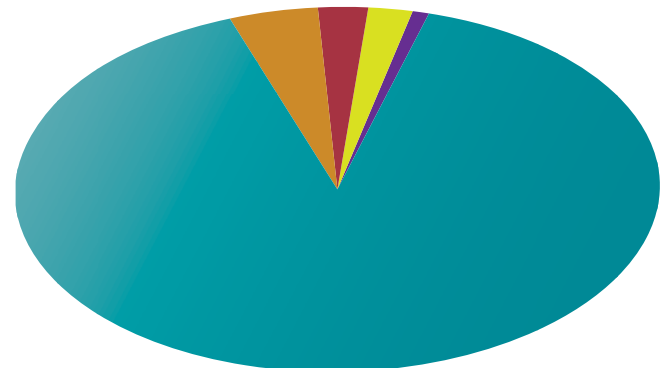
